



An Easter Egg story... for anyone old enough to eat chocolate (You need two small hollow chocolate eggs) Here's a fun way to connect chocolate Easter eggs with the story of Easter from the bible.

Sit down and enjoy peeling the foil wrapping off a hollow chocolate egg. Hold the egg in your hand but not too tightly so that it melts!

Jesus' tomb was a bit like this egg –with the big stone rolled against the tomb entrance, inside it must have been dark and cramped. It's as if the darkness makes it still Good Friday, the day that Jesus died. But on the first Easter day, Jesus came alive again, and burst out of the tomb. Good Friday is broken once and for all, and new life is set free.

At this point, feel free to smash the egg and start eating the pieces. While you eat, keep going with thinking through the story. But the trouble was, that nobody saw it happen. The soldiers who were guarding the tomb had fainted in fear, and the next thing we know, Mary arrives at Jesus' tomb and finds that it's empty. The actual moment of the resurrection happened in private. All that excitement and joy and nobody to share it! On Easter Sunday we focus on Mary's story. There in the garden, the resurrection had already happened, but she was trapped in her own Good Friday – her grief and sadness kept her in the dark.

Take your second chocolate egg, peel off the wrapping and hold it in your hand, just like you did with the first one. Just like the first egg, it's like Good Friday is still happening. It still felt like Good Friday to Mary. When we read Mary's story we can tell the exact moment when the resurrection happened for her –it's when Jesus calls her name and she recognises him. Suddenly all her sadness is turned to joy. Mary's Good Friday is gone once and for all, the new life is set free in her. You can smash and eat your second eqg now





## **EF Benson's 20th anniversary**

Members of the EF Benson Society recently commemorated the anniversary of the popular author's death. Benson was born in 1867, the fifth child of Edward White Benson, who later became Archbishop of Canterbury. He spent many years in Rye, living at Lamb House and was thrice Mayor of the town in the 1930s. The EF Benson Society was established in 1985 with the aim to pursue "the furtherance of the knowledge and appreciation of the Benson Family and in particular E F Benson, and to provide an opportunity for Benson enthusiasts to meet".

The Society organises a full programme of events culminating in the "Rye Day" when Bensonites gather from across the country enjoy a slap-up lunch and tea at Fletchers, a choice of walks and a fiendishly difficult quiz. This year, the Rye Day will take place on 11 July. Benson is buried in the cemetery at the top of Rye Hill. The group gathered around the grave while Keith Cavers, Chair of the Society, read an obituary of EF Benson written by his friend Francis Yeats-Brown which was published in the Spectator.

From 1620 it was a horse powered pump house for around 300 years and by 1907 it was used as a soup kitchen. The two large coppers have been preserved, each of which held around 70 gallons of soup. In 1976 this Grade 2 listed building was converted once more, this time into a public toilet, and after two long years of negotiations it finally opened on May 4 2018 as Rye's very own micro pub, the Waterworks, the first of its kind in Rye and the first in south east Sussex. This family run business has gone from strength to strength winning Campaign For Real Ale (CAMRA) awards along the way under the enthusiastic management of David

and Ulla Roder, serving eight local real ales, twelve local ciders and a good selection of gins, wines and soft drinks.

Waterworks best bitter was the only thing missing from the drinks menu so David and local, Tim Morgan decided to get it out of their cistern and produce their own beer. Being a former public loo the proposed new beer needed a subtle link to its history and the proud parents called their new addition. uRYEnal. The first pint of the secret brew was poured to a packed pub who's patience and eagerness to sample the 4.0% best bitter was finally rewarded and a deafening cheer cemented their seal of approval.

#### Supporting the Community in Rye & Beyond

Never before has there been a more urgent need for our communities to pull together than now when we need to focus on the really important issues we all face as the coronavirus establishes and spreads itself through the UK. In Rye we already have the benefit of REACT – the Rye Emergency Community Action Team – with Colonel Anthony Kimber as the driving force, which takes care of local emergencies as they occur. The REACT team has long established working relationships with Rother Emergency Planning, Rye Town Council and many other useful and supportive organisations. It is also happy to advise and support a recently created body, Rye Mutual Aid, a group of volunteers formed in response to the current pandemic crisis to help and take care of the community aid aspect.

Rye Mutual Aid was created last Sunday, March 15, and as of Tuesday night, the group of volunteers was close to 500, combining the members of their Facebook group and the people who are not on Facebook but have filled in their survey to become volunteers.

Rye Mutual Aid is in the process of identifying two key volunteers (known as dispatchers) for each of the ten sub zones of Rye and of the villages/or groups of villages in Rye's surrounding area.

Once this is done, Rye Mutual Aid will print (courtesy of Ian Foster at Adams of Rye) and distribute letters to each household in Rye and the surrounding area with the contact details of volunteer dispatchers, so that every person at home can call and get help.

- Checking in on people by phone
- Buying or picking up shopping
- Delivering/collecting things
- Posting mail
- Putting bins out
- Dog walking

Obviously Rye Mutual Aid is aware that there are some serious health and safety as well as security considerations with volunteers offering help to self-isolated people at this time but, following the example of many similar mutual aid groups around the country, general guidelines and essential advice has been written for the volunteers so that they keep safe and the residents keep safe too. These guidelines have been shared with Inspector Jonathan Hartley (Police, Hastings and Rother Prevention), with Anthony Kimber (REACT), with Richard Farhall (Rye Town Council) and with Nigel Ray (Rother Emergency Planning). The Rye Food Bank is currently dealing with a difficult situation as supermarket shelves are empty and essentials cannot be bought for the families and people who need it the most.

Chris Emson from the food bank mentioned that she tried to place an order for 40 bags of potatoes and could only get five. She is trying to source products from other suppliers, but funds are scarce. There is a particular worry about children who normally get a hot lunch at school as they are entitled to free school meals. When/if they have to stay at home, they might go a whole day without eating a hot meal. She is thinking of ways to provide hot meals.

In order to cover the costs of Rye Mutual Aid and to help support the fantastic effort of the food bank, a crowdfunding page has been created and nearly £500 was reached within a couple of hours! The target has been increased to make sure that the support for the foodbank is significant.

Letters will shortly be sent to local residents and information shared in the April edition of Rye Fixtures as well as updates from Rye News and if you feel you need help from Rye Mutual Aid then:

1. You can call the telephone number of the dispatcher of your area (numbers will be at the back of the letter to residents)

2. The dispatcher will find a volunteer able to help and let you know their name

3. If the volunteer needs to come to your house, he/she will be wearing a Rye Mutual Aid badge and you can ask their name

## **Coastal path thwarted**



The gap in the proposed Coast Path

Natural England has launched its consultation on the stretch of Coast Path from Eastbourne to Camber – but curiously this does not include the option of passing through Rye. The England Coast Path billed itself as "the longest managed and waymarked coastal path in the world" and was to act as an uninterrupted national trail around all of England's coast but the dangerous junction at the A259 and Rye Harbour Road proved too much for them and they conclude that "there is no safe road crossing point for pedestrians into Rye." Natural England went on to say, "We have investigated ways to improve the road crossing point here, including providing a traffic island at the road junction, a

pedestrian crossing over the A259 or by creating a pavement on the east side of Harbour Road to the junction.

"We have looked at other options to avoid this road junction, such as crossing Harbour Road further south and then crossing over the Environment Agency Sluice. Unfortunately, none of these options are possible."

The planners recognise that there is a long standing desire for a walking route around the River Rother via Rye but, because they are unable to make the crossing safe, it makes a continuous estuary route around the Rother "a complex and potentially prohibitively expensive undertaking."

It remains their aspiration to create an uninterrupted walking route (continued)

from Eastbourne to Camber and they mention "ongoing discussions regarding the creation of a footbridge across the river. "If such a development came to pass, or if the junction was made safe for pedestrians, we would investigate whether an estuary route is viable and, if appropriate, would prepare a separate variation report to the Secretary of State." It is unclear who has proposed the footbridge, or where it would be constructed, apart from the suggestion that a "local developer has an aspiration to construct a footbridge over the River Brede to the south of Rye." Rye News has reported on the dangerous junction previously, where the Rye Harbour Road, which is managed by East Sussex Highways, connects with the A259, which is the responsibility of Highways England. There are further concerns with the additional traffic that the new Discovery Centre will generate at the junction when it opens later this year. Rye Harbour Nature Reserve estimate that 360,000 people will visit each year, which is an increase of 66% since 2001, and the vast majority will visit by car. Rye Harbour Nature Reserve appreciates that at peak times there are too many cars for the parking spaces available and is working with

the Sussex Community Rail Partnership to promote visiting by others means, such as by rail and walking, on their website and in their literature.

But one must ask if that is wise when visitors arriving at Rye station and travelling to the Discovery Centre on foot must cross a junction that has been deemed unsafe. In a further knock-back for a continuous Coast Path around England, the path along the east side of the River Rother, which runs alongside the Rye Golf Club, will also not be included in the England Coast Path.

The report says that Rye Golf Club is concerned that if the existing path is linked with the Coast Path there "might be an increase in the number of walkers between Rye and Camber that might disrupt play and affect their management of the golf course, resulting in potential loss of income."

Walking around Rye and the Rother estuary should be a highlight of any England Coast Path, however it seems the town's on-going transport problems will result in a significant gap in Natural England's plans.

Natural England is currently contacting landowners and you can read the full report, that contains detailed maps, and comment on www.gov.uk. Deadline for comments is 23 April.


